FRIDAY, 13 NOVEMBER – Future Radio are releasing their debut album, "Freedom", on Friday, 13 November. This new 15-track concept album deals with the notion of emancipation from the ordinary and **encourages the passionate pursuit of purpose.**

"I think the idea of freedom is **universally relatable** and something that everybody yearns for", explains **front man Johnny Future**. "I wrote this album after quitting my 8-to-5 to **pursue music full-time**. So, in that sense, the album is based on my **real-life experience.**"

From the release of their first single, it was evident that Future Radio **doesn't plan to do things the traditional way**. The band consists of Johnny Future, who is in charge of the music and Drikus Roets, who creates the visuals that accompany each track on the album. **"We are storytellers at heart"**, Roets remarks, "combining words, music and visuals to tell multiple stories, which is a unique approach in itself, but all these elements are **ultimately interconnected**".

To celebrate the release of their debut album, Future Radio has announced an **international, online album launch** concert that will take place on Friday, 13 November 7:30 pm SAT. This concert will be the **first opportunity** for audiences to experience a Future Radio show and promises to be an **unforgettable** (never to be repeated) experience.
